We have got a lot of good feedback on the scientific program covering all aspects of our specialty, in addition to more generic sessions like pollution caused by anesthesia drugs and gases, DEI (diversity, equity, inclusion), artificial intelligence and climate crisis: implications for medical treatment, research methodology, medical papers including fraud and predatory journals and much more. We have a faculty of more than 100 dedicated speakers confirmed from the Nordic countries in addition to speakers from Germany, Belgium, Netherland, UK, USA, and Canada.
